1. Items Accepted

CirChic Boutique ("CirChic") accepts authentic British heritage fashion items (e.g. Barbour, Holland Cooper, Fairfax & Favor, Penelope Chilvers) in good, saleable condition. Items are subject to inspection and authentication. Counterfeit, damaged, or unsuitable items may be declined or returned.

2. Ownership & Permission to Sell

- The consignor confirms they are the legal owner of all items consigned to CirChic, and that the items are authentic and free of any claims or restrictions.
- By signing this agreement, the consignor gives CirChic full permission to photograph, list, market, and sell the items on their behalf.
- If any item is later found to be counterfeit or misrepresented, CirChic reserves the right to remove it from sale and return it, or dispose of it in line with legal obligations.

3. Commission & Fees

- The consignor will receive 60% of the final sale price once the item is sold.
- CirChic retains 40% commission for photography, styling, listing, marketing, and sales management.

- **Seller fees caveat:** If additional platform or payment processing fees apply (e.g. Vinted Pro, PayPal, Stripe), these may be deducted from the consignor's share.
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4. Payment

- Payouts are made via bank transfer within 14 working days of the buyer's return window closing.
 - Consignor must provide accurate bank details. CirChic is not liable for errors caused by incorrect details.
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5. Unsold Items

- Items may be listed for up to 3 months.
- After this period, CirChic will contact the consignor to arrange one of the following:
 1. Return of the item (at the consignor's expense if postage is required), or
 2. Extension of the consignment period, or
 3. Donation to a local charity partner, supporting community reuse and reducing fashion waste.
